

Palate Notes: A crisp, clean & fruity, yet dry, white wine with notes of ripe Bosc pear, white peaches and cantaloupe with hints of guava and honeysuckle. This wine is bone dry, with a medium body, crisp acidity and well-balanced tannins.

Serving Suggestions: A Spanish white varietal, it is a perfect "patio" wine (sip it by itself!) but pairs extremely well with very spicy foods including Mexican, Thai and Indian cuisines

Optimal Temperature: 42° F
